

# Lawyer in the Library Martinez

A clinic for self represented litigants

Lawyer in the Library is a program that offers unrepresented persons the opportunity to meet briefly with a volunteer attorney to get paperwork checked, or obtain answers to questions, or get general direction or information about a legal problem.

Because the sessions between clinic attendees and volunteer attorneys are brief (usually 15 to 20 minutes), it is important to maximize the time. Here are some tips to help accomplish that:

- DO indicate what result you are seeking. What are you trying to make happen? Or, what needs to change in your present situation?
- DO write your questions down and bring them to the meeting.
- DO bring any relevant legal papers, in case the attorney needs to see them.
- DO briefly summarize, in chronological order, the problem.
